\* For WIOA low income eligibility use the OMB Poverty column for families of one and the 70% LLSIL column for families of two or more.

1. Under WIOA LLSIL (WOTC) for family units of more than six (6) members, an amount equal to the difference between the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> member family units (\$6,012) should be added to the six (6) member family income level for each additional family member.
2. For WIOA 100% Poverty Income, add \$4,420 for each member over a family of eight (8).
3. For SCSEP add \$5,400 to the 125% Poverty Level income for each member over a family of eight (8).
4. For 200%, add \$8,640 for each member over a family of eight (8).
